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## May 26, 2022 Horse Council Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:03 by Forellen Bonham

Attendance: Jennifer Dailey, Josey Pukrop, Frances Cabral, Barb Howe, Forellen Bonham, Bella Dastur, Natalie Lowman, Cindy Lowman, Adrienne Lehmkuhl and Kaitlyn Guffer

Bella Dastur led the American Pledge and Frances Cabral led the 4-H pledge.

Natalie Lowman presented the treasurer's report. The beginning balance of the checking account was \$8,535.42, \$160.00 was received in income, amount spent for the checking account \$689.29 and the ending balance was \$8,006.13. The beginning balance of the savings account was \$4,511.04, \$0.03 in interest was received, and the ending balance \$4,511.07. The total for all accounts was \$12,517.20. Horse judging balance was \$424.82. The horse bowl balance was \$331.35.

Frances Cabral read the March 28 and April 28 meeting minutes. Natalie motioned to approve the April 28 minutes and Adrienne seconded. Bella motioned to approve the March 28 minutes and Kaitlyn seconded.

For the horse judging report we were continuing judging ranch riding and Halter classes. We were also discussing plans for the next contest that is on June 5th in El Paso County.

**Announcements:** The next horse council meeting is on June 23 at 6 pm. The horse show schedule is out in the lifeline, please check it out. Horse council now has a form that clubs have to complete to borrow horse council items such as the timer. The next county council meeting is on June 7 at 6pm. The horse shows we had coming up this month were Pleasant park gymkhana on June 5, Gilpin Archwood show June 12 and Trio show on June 26. The Pleasant park gymkhana and Gilpin Archwood show count for end of year high point. High point tracking :all points will be added a week after each show. Make sure to continue doing your record books and doing the Community service requirement and demos for your clubs. Stan Sours are activities and community service opportunities that could get you a \$500 scholarship. The Friday lifeline newsletter is out so check it out. Make sure you all are continuing to recycle your twine.

**Unfinished/Old business:** Hairy Horse show went really well. We talked about some feedback about the judge as well. The carnival extravaganza was a success, everyone enjoyed it, and it made a good amount of money for Horse Council.

### **New business:**

We talked about taking suggestions for changing the bylaws and everyone thought they looked good. We discussed our 2022 - 2023 proposed budget and voted. We need volunteer sign ups for the county fair, we need adults to administer tests on July 30, we need lots of volunteers on July 31 for the pleasure show and we need a few volunteers on August 1 for the gymkhana. We also wanted to give Horse Judging \$85 for the Junior invitational competition. Bella motioned to spend the \$85 and I seconded.
