### Position Minimum Qualifications

- Must hold a degree in elementary, early childhood, or environmental education or have 3 months full-time or equivalent (455 hours) verifiable experience working with groups of 4 or more children. Babysitting cannot be counted. (Applicants that do not hold an applicable degree, must submit letter(s) of experience verification before being granted an interview.)
- Ability to hike moderate to difficult trails while carrying all related equipment.
- Certification in First Aid/CPR or ability to obtain certification before camp (a class will be offered).
- Educators must be at least 18 years of age, due to childcare licensing requirements; Educator/Van drivers must be at least 20 years of age, possess a valid driver's license issued by the State of Colorado and satisfactorily clear an MVR check.
- To ensure the program meets adult/child ratios consistently, applicants are asked to be available to work the entire 5 weeks of employment.
- Must satisfactorily clear FBI/CBI fingerprint print & child abuse background checks to be considered.

### Preferred Qualifications

- Passion for the outdoors & connecting youth with nature
- Sense of curiosity & adventure
- Strong background in natural sciences, environmental education
- Some knowledge of outdoor safety skills & Leave No Trace techniques
- Bilingual

### Essential Job Duties

- Ensure the safety of 10 campers, while hiking, & leading experiential learning activities
- Check-in and out campers daily following Colorado State Day Care Licensing requirements
- Prepare and lead each day's activities in a meaningful and engaging way while following curriculum and philosophy of the program; organize and care for associated equipment.
