As a volunteer youth leader, you will...

- hone leadership skills by assisting camp staff in hands-on activities
- as a positive role model, assist in providing a safe, healthy, and enjoyable experience to all campers
- develop general leadership, and goal setting skills that you can use beyond the camp experience
- earn 40 hours community service for school requirements, or for college applications
- form lifetime friendships with peers with like interests

Qualifications of a youth leader:

- opportunity for youth 16-18 years old. Must be 16 by June 8, 2026
- have a desire to work with children in a camp setting
- demonstrated maturity, energy, enthusiasm, communication skills
- an interest in environmental education and youth development
- ability to work effectively as a member of a team
- willingness to learn and develop new skills in a variety of camp settings
- physical ability to work in an outdoor camp setting which includes hiking sometimes to high elevations

Specific duties of a youth leader:

- assist educators with daily activities
- assist with check-in procedures
- be extra support for children with special needs
- help educators lead campers on trails
- prepare educational games to play with campers
- report any unsafe actions or bullying by campers
- set an example of a person with good character, integrity, and adaptability
- other duties as assigned by site supervisor or educators

STEPS TO APPLY

4. Attend an interview – interviews are scheduled after application and 3 references are completed

6. Commit to at least one consecutive week of camp.
